BILGIN 263, the biggest yacht to be built in Turkey, is not a project anymore. The shipyard has been constructing since March, as announced earlier.

Works are grinding on expeditiously at Bilgin's Yalova facilities. 7 of total 25 blocks of the steel hull is about to finish. The luxury yacht builder is planning to begin the block assembly and superstructure building in July. She will be powered by two MTU 16V 4000 M63R engines, which will be delivered this November. As announced by the shipyard, her launch is scheduled for Mach 2017, then she is going to be delivered to Bilgin's new shipyard at West Istanbul Marina.

Defined as 'the trendsetter of super yachts' by his designer, BILGIN 263 was created by Unique Yacht Design and she is the third project, Bilgin will fulfill for this specific client. Not only does this super yacht meet the exacting performance standards of the luxury industry but sets the bar for Turkey's growing high-end yacht sector. Her size, slim outlook, fuel efficiency and comfort makes her a leader in both creativity and execution with a surprising amount of luxury space for each guest under her sleek shape. The 80m, which will be built to ABS class and fully LY3 compliant, is going to be the largest yacht built by Bilgin Yachts Shipyard. Her delivery date is 2019.
